- **READ: The Gospel according to Mark (all 16 chapters)** in your Study Bible
 - Bring one or more Study Bibles with you on Sept. 8
- **READ: The Intro Chapters and the Chapter on the Gospel of Mark** in whichever textbook(s) you have chosen to obtain and use this year:

also *skim* Ch. 2 & 3 (*as time permits*)
 - Or: **Mark Allan POWELL**: Chapters 1-3 and **6**
 - Or: **Margaret Nutting RALPH**: Chapters 1–3
