Prayer and Action Mission experience is quickly approaching. Here are a few of the details you may want to know.

July 15	Our Mother of Sorrows Parish, Tucson	12:00

Departure is NOON on Friday.

If you have not turned in your medical and permission forms. They must be in before you attend the mission. If you have **not** turned in your forms by the Wednesday before your work week, please **do not** put them in the mail. Take them with you to the registration location and give them to the Prayer and Action team.

We have also included a checklist of items that should be brought on the trip. They include:

1. A water bottle
2. Work clothes (something appropriate to paint in), all shirts must have sleeves.  
*Remember there is a lot of sweat work and no laundry facilities.*
3. Recreational clothes
4. Towel
5. Sun Screen
6. Notebook/journal to write in with a writing utensil.
7. Recreational activities (playing cards, frisbees, football, etc)
8. Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, sanitary items, etc)
9. Snack food (please label containers and bags to keep together for each group)
10. Sleeping bag (a blow-up mattress would be ok)
11. Pillow and extra blanket

We will make efforts to make the showers as private as possible, and we will also have separate times in which the students and the adult leaders will be able to shower. However, if a student would like to have even more privacy, we recommend they bring a bathing suit to shower in. We would also like to ask you to bring a few supplies such as paint brushes, scrapers, plant snippers, hedge trimmers, and maybe a few other common tools. *(For painting and yard work)* Each group may also bring with them a few snacks for the students to eat should they get hungry between meals or during their free time.

Our daily schedule is as follows:

6:00 Wake up and meet for morning reflections  
6:30 Breakfast and prepare sack lunches  
7:00 Travel to work sites and begin work  
12:30 Clean up and leave work site  
1:00 Mass  
1:30 Lunch  
2:30 Showers and free time  
3:30 Adult leader meeting  
4:00 Evening activity  
5:30 Evening Prayer and Rosary  
6:00 Dinner  
7:00 Collatio (Large group, skit, prayer, and worship time)  
8:15 Parish group time followed by free time  
9:45 Night prayer  
10:00 Lights out!

### *Important Reminders:*

- 1. Adult Sponsors MUST be 25 years of age or older and have a current VIRTUS (good for 5 yrs after completing) or CMG Connect Training and Background check*
- 2. You have pre-registered, so Payment is due ASAP to keep your spots in the chosen week*
- 3. Completed Forms are Due May 1, 2018.*

# PRAYER AND ACTION

## CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Youth at this Activity represent the Catholic youth of the Diocese of Tucson. They are expected to act like young men and women.
2. Youth are not to leave the work site or lodging facilities without the company of their adult sponsor or Prayer and Action Team Member.
3. Use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, and/or drugs will result in automatic expulsion from Prayer and Action.
4. Youth cannot enter the rooms provided for the opposite sex.
5. Youth must respect the authority of the adults who have been placed in a supervisory capacity.
6. Participants are to maintain **QUIET** in their sleeping rooms and in the halls in consideration of other participants.
7. The dress for Prayer and Action is casual. Shirts must have sleeves. Shorts must be an appropriate length.
8. Youth are expected to attend **ALL** the Prayer and Action activities.
9. **SOCIALIZING PRIOR TO CURFEW** should be done in the public areas of the facility since noise levels must be kept to a minimum in the sleeping areas. This guarantees the right to privacy and to peace and quiet for other attendees. Please be respectful of these other persons and use designated rooms for sleeping, not for visiting.
10. **NO VISITING IS ALLOWED IN SLEEPING ROOMS BY YOUTH OF THE OPPOSITE SEX.**
11. All participants are expected to respect other's property. Please leave all areas in good condition. (Neat & Tidy!)
12. All participants are expected to be courteous to all speakers.

*We respectfully ask for your cooperation and are sure that you will have no trouble adhering to this simple code of behavior. As a participant, you must remember that you represent the Church and must project an image of Christian consideration, sensitivity, and respect to others and to the property around you.*
