

# Vocation Art Contest

*Seek, Find and Go for it*

**Diocese of Tucson**

## **Topic**

A drawing or photograph (by category) related to the vocational theme: the call of God, the different vocational paths such as the priesthood, the contemplative/religious life, vocations discernment, God calling youth to serve in the Church. You can also draw a picture of the Diocese of Tucson' priest and religious living their vocation by means of serving in their parish life and ministry.

## **Recipients**

### **Drawing competition**

- (4<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade).
- 4<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade students enrolled in schools (public and religious) for the 2018-19 school year. Parishes and movements of the Diocese of Tucson will be able to participate in the contest.

### **Photography and video contest**

- only students enrolled in 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and High School.
- Adolescents and young enrolled in 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and High School of the schools (public and catholic) 2018-19 school year. Parishes and movements of the Diocese of Tucson may participate in the contest.

## **Rules**

### **Drawing competition**

- It will be presented in paper or cardboard format.
- The drawing will be done with free technique: colored pencils, markers, waxes, tempera paints, watercolors, charcoal pencil.
- On the back of the drawing the title of the drawing will be indicated along with the name or pseudonym.
- Along with the drawing, the registration form that is attached in these bases will be presented, which will indicate: contest to which is submitted (drawing), name and surname, date of birth, full address, telephone, e-mail , course and school, parish or movement. Works that do not meet this requirement will not be accepted.
- Each student may only present a work that is unpublished. The submitted works will not be returned.

## **Photography and video contest**

- It will be necessary to present the registration form of the same that is attached in these bases, which will indicate: contest to which it is submitted, name and surname, date of birth, full address, telephone, e-mail, course and school, parish or movement, indicating the date and time of sending the photo by email. Works that do not meet this requirement will not be accepted.
- It will be necessary to send or present in the Diocesan of Tucson and USB, or electronic file. The video file must not exceed more than five minutes of production. It must include a word format with the title of the video, the author, each team member's name, the contact telephone, course, school or parish, and an email.
- Each student may only present a work that is unpublished.

## **Awards**

**5 prizes** will be awarded according to the categories.

The winners will be announced on March 11 on the Diocese of Tucson Vocations Page at [diocesetucson.org/vocations](http://diocesetucson.org/vocations). The winners will be notified by telephone before said date. The prizes will be delivered by Fr Jorge Ricardo Farias to the Catholic School or Parish on the week of March 11<sup>th</sup>.

## **Jury**

The jury will be integrated by experts in the vocational subject as well as people qualified in artistic expression. The jury's decision will be final.

## **Delivery and delivery time**

The deadline for submission of the works will be March 1, 2019, before 5:00 pm.
