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PETITIONER'S QUESTIONNAIRE

The following questions require details. They are intended to give an initial account of the total relationship of the parties from meeting to final separation. Additional information may be needed during the process.

AVOID "YES" AND "NO" ANSWERS UNLESS IT IS CLEAR THERE IS NO OTHER ANSWER.

Please be aware that only you and your former spouse may review the testimonies gathered during the investigation near the end of the process.

It will be very much appreciated if you will

- Answer each question with as much detail as possible, clearly numbering the question being answered;
 - Type your answers or write your answers clearly in black ink on white paper;
 - Use letter size paper and write on one side only; and
 - *Do not write your answers on the questionnaire.*

MEETING & COURTSHIP

1. Please describe, each spouse dating history before your courtship.
2. Describe how you met; your attraction to each other and how long you dated before deciding to marry.
3. How did you practice your Christian faith before marriage?
4. Please indicate any significant disappointments, problems, substance abuses, break-ups/reconciliations etc. during dating.
5. Did either of you set any conditions before agreeing to marry?
6. Did either of you have any doubts about entering marriage, or were you advised not to marry?
7. Did the problems originating during the courtship ultimately cause the separation/divorce?

WEDDING & HONEYMOON

8. Were plans for the wedding day mutually made?
9. Did you withhold any information from each other or the priest/minister as you prepared for the ceremony?
10. Did either of you suppress any "second thoughts" about going through this marriage ceremony?
11. Did any family member or friend ask or suggest that this was not the right time to marry?
12. Was the honeymoon a pleasant experience?

MARRIED LIFE

13. When did you first notice a potential problem in the marriage?
14. What steps were taken to correct this difficulty?



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- 15. Did any issues with intimacy arise in your relationship?
- 16. Did the attitudes of either spouse change about children, fidelity, or permanence?
- 17. When was the first threat made about separation and/or divorce?
- 18. Did legal or illegal substances influence the married life; and/or did emotional - physical – sexual abuse take place in this marriage?
- 19. Did civil authorities or family members have to intervene during this marriage?

FINAL SEPARATION

- 20. Who made the decision to civilly end the marriage and for what reason?
- 21. If you had children, what provisions were made and carried out for their care (i.e emotional, religious, educational, and material wellbeing)?
- 22. Please give details regarding other cohabitation(s) and/or marriage(s) since your final separation/divorce.
- 23. What responsibility do you bear for the failure of this marriage?

PERSONAL BACKGROUND

- 24. Please give a general background prior to the marriage of your strengths and weaknesses that each of you brought into the marriage.

CANONICAL REASON FOR A DECLARATION OF NULLITY

- 25. I believe that the Catholic Church should declare our life together to be an invalid sacramental union because of the following reason (ground):

I, the undersigned, declare under penalty of perjury, that the answers I have given, are the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth. SO HELP ME GOD.

I further promise that I will not discuss this information with any other party or the witnesses that I have named, until the case has been concluded.

- Church marriage certificate
- Final decree of divorce or Certificate of Dissolution for the marriage in question
- If baptized, a certificate of baptism (if possible for both parties)
 - For Catholics, a recent Baptismal certificate that has been dated within the last six months and includes all the marginal notations – Contact the parish of baptism.
 - For non-Catholics, furnish whatever proof of baptism you either have or can obtain from the Church of baptism.

Before sending the paperwork to the Tribunal Office, please submit to the Pastor or Pastoral Minister in your parish, or the parish of your intended spouse, who is helping you with the process.
